Rules:

- Snowshoes must be at least twice as long as your boots (except youth 12 & under)
- Participants set out at 1 minute intervals
- A series of 3 "shots" before and after running the course. Once a "hit" is scored racer may proceed. Shooting time is included in overall time.
- 3 Tosses of the bean bag to get one "hit" Otherwise a penalty lap around the traffic "circle." (Youth racers excepted, they still shoot but no penalty.)
- Slower racers must yield trail to faster. (Be courteous, no gold medals here.)
- The Youth race has a short section of 2-way trail. The racer finishing the course has right-of-way. Racer beginning may proceed parallel to the trail on the right hand side.
- Use of ski poles is permitted.

Long Course: Forest Loop East 1.45km — **Youth Course:** Abreviated Park Loop 0.6km

Timing will be done manually and may not necessarily be real accurate.
